



## GENERAL RULES OF CONDUCT

The spectator who is entitled to access and remain inside the sports facility during rugby matches, during the Coronavirus emergency period, must comply, in addition to the behavioral rules contained in the "Regulations for use of the Association of 21 September 2019" and the "Protocol for the open door organization of rugby matches at the rugby stadium in Monigo (TV) - measures to contain the epidemiological risk covid-19" of ....., also the specific additional rules of conduct specified below, aimed at safeguarding and protecting public health, one's own and others.

Users are informed in advance that, by express legislative provision (National Decrees, Regional Ordinances and Guidelines), Benetton Rugby is obliged to keep the attendance lists of all the people who have access to the facility for 14 days following the event / match, so as to be able to trace the presence in the event of an ascertained COVID.

Failure to comply with the rules of conduct will result in the inhibition of the validity of the ticket on the day of the match; based on the severity, the Association will evaluate whether to extend the inhibition also for subsequent matches.

### ACCESS TITLE AND ACCESS PROCEDURES

- The admission ticket can be purchased mainly online where a self-certification will be completed.
- When purchasing the ticket, the person signs a self-certification in which he declares that at the time of purchase of the ticket he is not subject to quarantine and declares that in the event that during the day of the match he was in quarantine, he will not show up for the match .
- The spectator will be able to access the facility / stadium only after measuring their body temperature.
- The spectator will be able to access the facility / stadium only if equipped with suitable PPE (TO BE INTENDED AS MINIMUM SURGICAL FACIAL MASK) that is able to cover the respiratory tract (nose-mouth).
- Access to the prefiltration area must take place in an orderly manner following the signs present and the indication of the stewards present outside the plant / stadium. Also in this phase, the interpersonal distancing of one meter from each other must be respected.
- In order to avoid crowds, the spectator must respect the access queue and any slowdown without proceeding undisciplined towards the control area.
- After validation of the ticket, the spectator will be able to sanitize their hands using dispensers placed in the plant / stadium area.
- All people who access the system must also:
  - show the ticket, together with a valid identity document,
  - submit the self-certification / certification bearing the outcome of the Covid-19 negativity test performed at least 48 hours before the event,
  - or the certification of vaccination,
  - or a certificate attesting to the cure from Covid-19 in a period not earlier than 6 (six months) from the date of the event,

### PROHIBITIONS

- Access to the facility / stadium is prohibited for spectators who do not respect even one of the above points
- If the measured body temperature is greater than or equal to 37.5 °, the person will be subjected to a second check and, if confirmed, invited to return home and follow the procedures provided by the Government and local health facilities.
- It is forbidden to create gatherings.
- It is expressly forbidden to remove PPE unless expressly requested by the authorities or in areas intended for the consumption of food / beverages.
- It is forbidden to bring banners, flags or other material into the stadium.

### SERVICES ATTACHED TO THE STRUCTURE AND SORTING ROUTES

The spectator must wear PPE along the routes and in queues, while waiting to access the toilets, in correspondence with the catering, food & beverage or merchandising areas present in the structure / stadium.

- The access routes to the stands / sectors will be managed by the steward staff to ensure the orderly flow of the public to reach the position indicated in the entrance ticket. The spectator must therefore respect the instructions provided by the appropriate staff and keep the waiting position in case of slowdown to reach the place.
- In the service areas that allow an interpersonal distance greater than 1 meter, it will be possible to consume food and drinks ensuring a non-promiscuous position with other spectators.
- each toilet will be managed by stewards for the alignment procedure in the waiting areas, and sanitizing dispensers will be available before and after the use of the services. The use of non-delimited wall-mounted urinals inside men's bathrooms must be done by observing the signs; the usable urinal will be highlighted by a green dot while the use of the urinal with a red dot is inhibited

### PROHIBITIONS

- It is absolutely forbidden to create gatherings during the consumption of food and drinks.
- There must be no gatherings in correspondence with the sorting areas to access the stands.
- In case of replacement of PPE it is necessary that they are thrown in the appropriate baskets.
- It is forbidden to use the lift; the lift is for the exclusive use of disabled people (who will be accompanied by a steward), elderly people, and pregnant women.

### PERMANENCE IN THE STANDS

- All spectators must wear PPE (face mask).
- The interpersonal distance of 1 meter that the Association has previously guaranteed with the allocation of seats (indicated in the admission title) must be maintained, placing empty seats between the various spectators that must in no way be occupied.
- The spectator will access the stands according to the instructions provided by the stewards, avoiding gatherings and following the indications of the signs prepared for the match.
- The spectator will leave the stands at the end of the match following the indications and instructions provided by the speaker and the stewards present, avoiding crowds, unnecessarily prolonging his stay inside the stadium, and always maintaining the distance.

All the Benetton Rugby staff and the stewards present will be available to the user for the entire duration of the match for any further requests for clarifications and needs that may arise during the event / match.
